"Science Stamps" Program

Science Stamps are an incentive program designed to reward you for doing good things. For example, you can"

- Participate—offer at least 5 worthy comments per week
- Get a perfect score on a test
- Get perfect attendance for one week
- Turn in all work for one week
- Win a review game with your team
- Correctly answer a bonus question, puzzle or problem
- Be cooperative or helpful in an outstanding manner (help classmates, volunteer, clean, etc.)
- Follow classroom rules for a grading period (no green slips, tardies, lab accidents, etc.)
- Feed the class pets for a week
- Go "above and beyond" with a project using your talents, creativity, etc.
- Run an errand, help with recycling, water plants
- Tally science stamps on the clipboard for a class
- Others to be announced

Mrs. Jacobs adds science stamps daily to her clipboard. At the end of each grading period, they will be tallied. Prizes are awarded each grading period as follows:

10 = candy

15 = sticker

20 = bel ringer pass

25 = small prize (pencil, eraser, pen, etc.)

30 = homework pass (good for any 5 point or less homework assignment)

35 = 5 bonus points

40= 5 more bonus points

Every 10 science stamps entitle you to a special raffle ticket. Raffle tickets are drawn once per grading period from a "Chinese Auction" for small prizes. The more stamps you get, the more chances you have to win.

This program was developed to reward you for being a positive student, to bring out your potential and get you to use the skills and virtues society values. Enjoy!
